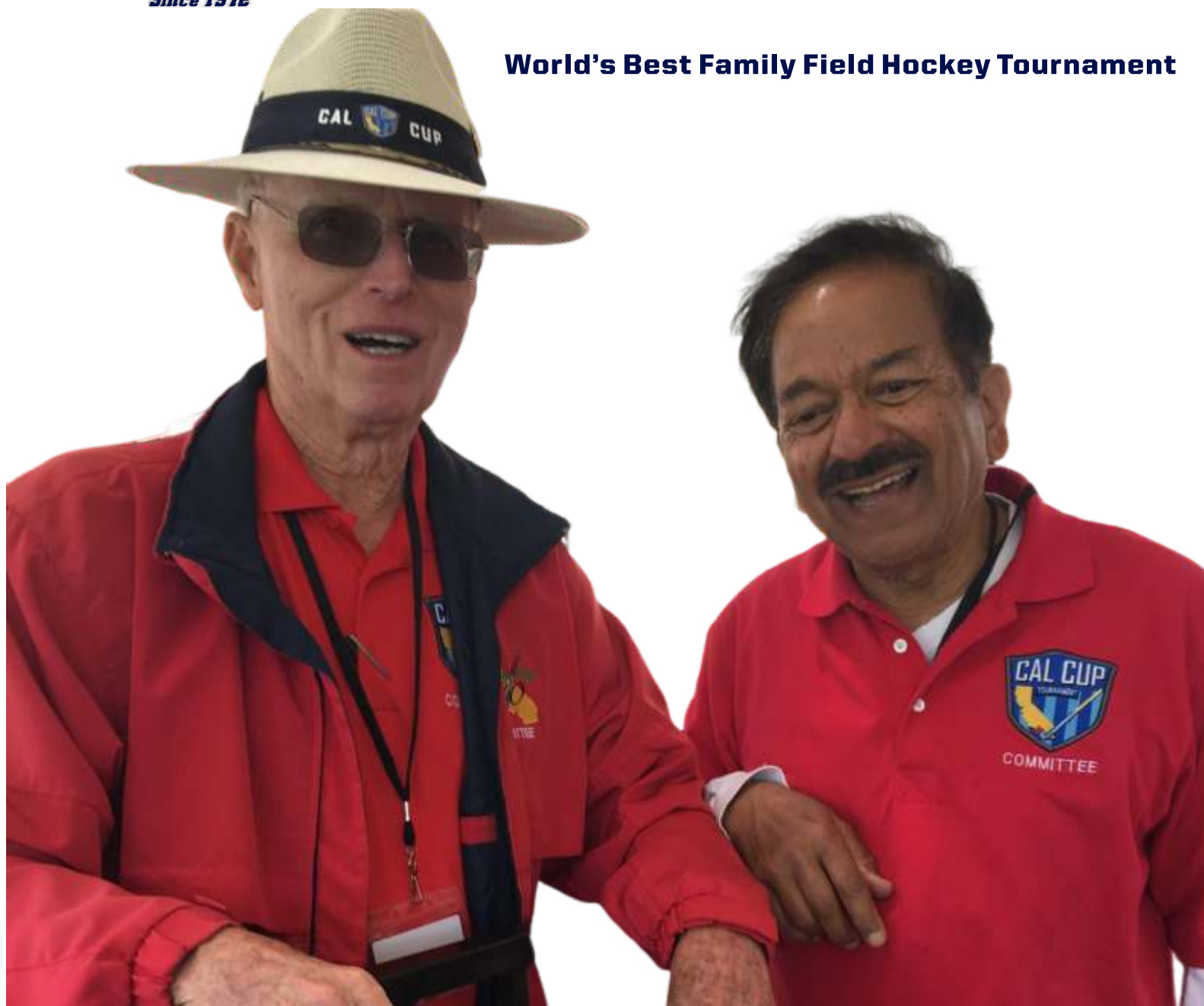

This year, we honor Tom in a way that feels like a homecoming. On May 25 at 5pm, with dignitaries from the LA28 Olympic organizing committee, USA Field Hockey's CEO, Simon Hoskins and Chairman, Chip Rogers, and Moorpark's Mayor, Chris Enegren and Mayor Pro Tem, Renee Delgado by our side, we will celebrate Tom's induction into the USA Field Hockey Hall of Fame. It's a moment to reflect on a man who, in 1972, founded the Cal Cup with a dream; who, as an engineer, poured his own resources into building Harris Family Field; and who, in 1984, gave us the Field Hockey Federation and the Conejo Bulldogs Club. Tom's love for field hockey is woven in every corner of this stadium, is a living museum of dedication and memorials, a sanctuary where players and fans feel at home.

At 89, Tom will take the field for his 53rd Cal Cup appearance on May 24, a testament to his enduring passion. As you walk the grounds, cheer for your teams, or share stories with old friends, I invite you to feel the magic of this place, magic that exists because Tom invested his heart and soul into creating a community that welcomes all.

To our players, from the youngest to our seasoned veterans, representing 18 nations, you are the heartbeat of Cal Cup. To our volunteers, coaches, and families, your dedication keeps Tom's vision alive. And to our fans, your cheers make every moment unforgettable. This tournament, lovingly called the Tom Harris Tournament, is a celebration of not just field hockey, but of the connections we forge and the memories we create together.

Please join us for the special ceremony on May 25 to honor Tom, a man whose kindness and generosity have touched us all. Let's raise our sticks, share our smiles, and give thanks for the legend who made this family possible. Here's to the Cal Cup, to Tom Harris, and to the love that binds us across generations.

The US Men's Field Hockey Foundation would like to extend their heartfelt congratulations to one of California's field hockey Founding Fathers, Mr. Tom Harris. Tom founded Cal Cup in 1972 and played a pivotal role in encouraging the growth of the Field Hockey Federation (FHF) in the subsequent years alongside other dedicated volunteers. This effort led to renewed growth culminating in the 1984 Olympics, where many FHF founders participated.

Tom is a visionary who realized that for hockey to flourish in Southern California, a dedicated facility was necessary. With his longstanding relationship with Moorpark College and their agreement, Tom engineered and planned the construction of what is now Harris Field. This field has seen over 30 years of US Men's, Junior Men's, and League play for both men and women, boys and girls. Impressively, over 70% of the US Men's national team, including Juniors, came from FHF at Harris Family Field.

Tom has been a member of the Cal Cup committee for all its 53 years. Teams from all over the world have participated with teams from India, UK, Australia, Canada, Mexico, Taiwan and Nigeria. Tom also played at every Cal Cup and, at the age of 89, expressed concerns that some of the mixed social teams were not quite up to his standard. However, Alan Scally assured him that the Conejo Bulldogs would rise to the occasion for Tom's USAFH Hall of Fame year.

The US Men's Field Hockey Foundation heartily congratulates this field hockey icon, who has not only grown the game but loves it passionately. Tom Harris has probably watched more USA International Hockey games in person than anyone currently alive. His contributions to sport are unparalleled, and his legacy will continue to inspire future generations.

Also coaching, volunteering, and attending the National Hockey Festivals, Guru Nanak tournaments and of course every Cal Cup since 1985.

There are many adults who still play today that were coached by him in their youth as he encouraged many kids and adults to play hockey and would always find a place for anyone wanting to play field hockey.

He returned to the practice of law and developed the Madison-Lincoln Initiative out of his concern that Americans are increasingly polarized into two dominant political tribes which have become increasingly extreme and increasingly hostile to "the other side", with threats of another Civil War and violent confrontations becoming normalized. The Madison-Lincoln Initiative seeks to promote constitutional literacy, civic engagement, and civil discourse among America's youth as an antidote to the disintegration of our common bond.

The name of our non-profit organization recognizes the role of James Madison, fourth president of the United States and chief architect of the US Constitution, and Abraham Lincoln, sixteenth president of the United States, whose leadership through the Civil War resulted in the adoption of the 13th, 14th, and 15th amendments to the Constitution, thus ending the scourge of slavery and guaranteeing all Americans the "Equal Protection" of the laws. Although our nation would not achieve full equality until women were finally given the right to vote through the 19th amendment and the pernicious Jim Crow laws were banished by the Civil Rights Act, the influence of presidents Madison and Lincoln on the Constitution that has bound our nation for a quarter-millennium cannot be overstated.

Madison-Lincoln Student Clubs: Following a presentation from our Founder, if students at any high school or college are interested, The Madison-Lincoln Initiative will help students organize and maintain a Madison-Lincoln club dedicated to promoting the three pillars we teach: constitutional literacy, civic engagement, and civil discourse. Madison-Lincoln Club meetings typically feature debate and discussion of political issues, as well as interviews with candidates for public office in order to foster informed and respectful discourse, and to encourage civic engagement within the framework of the US Constitution.

He has taught at every level of higher education, and was twice honored by students as Outstanding Instructor at Sierra Community College.
